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1 Introduction

This is the fourth quarterly report of prices and quantities of agricultural produce sold through the Municipal and Roadside Market in Tongatapu. Municipal Market includes Talamahu Market and Siamelie Market in which they are under the authority of Tonga Market Corporation Limited.

The report contains information on:

- (i) Monthly and quarterly average weights in kilograms of the common trade units of each produce that is sold at the market.
- (ii) Monthly and total quarterly supplies of agricultural produce in common trade units and in tons
- (iii) Monthly and quarterly average prices of agricultural produce sold in the market in price per common trade unit and in price per kilogram.

The data on the volume of supply of each produce, in common trade units are source from the Roadside Markets by the staff of the Policy and Planning Division of MAFF on every Friday and Saturday.

Random sample of produce are chosen from the Municipal and Roadside Market and weight, every Friday and Saturday. During the survey, random samples of five common trade units weighed, and their respective prices recorded. Price and weight information from the survey then used to derive the total volume (in metric ton) and value of supply of produce.

Readers should note that the Municipal Market and Roadside Market are the major market outlets in Tongatapu that represents at least 80% of separate outlets for the sale of agricultural produce.

Roadside Market means agricultural produce sells in the main island of Tongatapu along Vuna Road from Ma'ufanga to Lapaha Village. The subsistence and trade through markets in Vava'u, Ha'apai and 'Eua are not included due to consistency of market data received.

The supply data and information provided represents produce that entered the Municipal Market and Roadside Market. Therefore, any unsold produce removed from these markets are not record. The other notes regarding the data provided in these tables given in the following chapter. The Agricultural Export figures and values provided in the Statistics Department Foreign Trade Reports and the MAFF Quarantine Annual Report.

Any comments and suggestions for improvement on this report welcomed, as this will assist us greatly in our goal of continuous improvement of client services.

Explanatory Notes

Monthly averages

- The monthly averages used in this report are simple averages of the weekly prices and weights.

Quarterly Averages

- The quarterly averages of weights and prices given in these tables are weighted averages. They computed by multiplying the monthly average by month supply; summing these for the three months, and dividing by the total supply over three months.

Missing data – Monthly Averages

- Occasionally, data is report for supply, but no corresponding monthly average reported. This situation arises when there is supply during the week, but not at the time of sampling. When no monthly average or weight recorded, then that average omitted from the calculation of quarterly averages even when produce recorded as being supply during that month.
- For calculation of that month's supply in tons, when the monthly average weight is missing, the supply in common trade units is multiplied by the quarterly average weight of the common trade units, which is calculated as described in the previous paragraph.

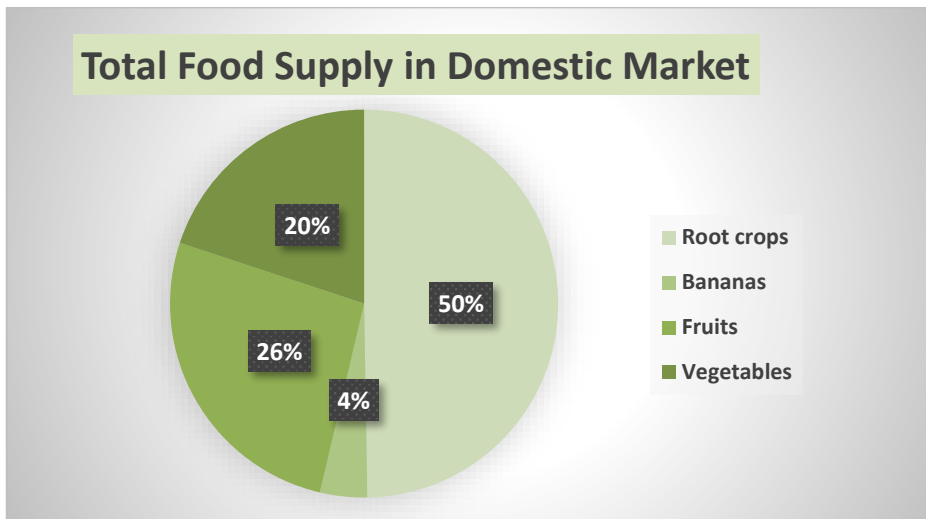
